Minutes of meeting, Spittalfield, 16th February 2011, 1930

- Fiona Matthews was thanked for her fine presentation on Alzheimer Scotland.
- Flowers will be sent to Mrs Harmon in memory of Brian's SDCC service.
- Minutes of meeting of 17th November 2010 were taken as read (RMcl & GR)
- There was no police report. **AE** will check the mail list (for police and ST).
- No matters of public matters of concern were raised.
- Matters arising from minutes: Parking in Bridge Road Caputh - **BV** is checking; Murthly restaurant – SEPA has raised an objection that flooding poses a significant risk. The planning department & committee will consider.
- The idea of revising planning policy to take account of recent hard winters was discussed. The issue of too much grit on roads at Murthly was raised. **Potholes – all are asked to record potholes via the Perth & Kinross Council central number 01738 475000.** **AW** will send a link to members for this issue.
- Development Plan for Perth and Kinross Main Issues report: nothing to report.
- Councillors' and area reports: Murthly – as above; crows are a problem. **ST** will seek advice from Alan Stewart, wildlife officer with police. Shop light signs planning application – no final date had been set for decision.
- Caputh – awaiting signage repairs & changes. A new notice board is needed.
- Clunie – Ditches cleaned; signage done; road damage as everywhere else.
- Meikleour – **AE** will mention the abandoned car to police. The footpath by the hedge needs cleaning and **CF** will contact PKC roads department.
- Spittalfield –no proposals to reinstate the Post Office. **HR & GR** will inspect the new noticeboard lying at Caputh and speak to Sir G Lyle about its installation.
- **BV** will contact the owners of a bright west-facing light on the A984 at Stenton.
- It was agreed to pay the CPKCC Subscription for 2011.
- The issue of raised heating oil prices affecting rural residents was discussed.
- Telephone boxes: **BV** (and **AW**) will pursue within PKC the legalities of transfer of ownership from BT to residents' associations. **AE** will inform BT that we intend to pursue this matter at Craigie and Spittalfield.
