Minutes of Meeting Meikleour 14th September 2011: 7.30 pm


- Present: Hazel Robertson, Chic Fleming, Alasdair Wylie, Barbara Vaughan, Scott Tod, Roddy McInnes, Jean Rae, Anton Edwards + 3 public
- Apologies: Graham Reid, Margaret Edwards
- Minutes of the last meeting of June 15th were adopted (proposed JR seconded ST)
- The police report from Pitlochry was received drawing attention to licensed premise and garden building break-ins.
- Public matters of concern: A document has been received locally from National Grid about a proposal to convert a local gas-transport pipeline to CO2-transport. **AW** will report on relevant correspondence.
- Matters arising from minutes: all seen to. At Isla Bridge, the Roads Dept has unexpected problems with traffic light power supply but in the meantime the bridge is a little inconvenient. The Stanley speed hump is doing its job and signage has been installed.
- Councillors' reports:
 - AW** reported a council energy saving initiative funding bid for home insulation over most of this area (SCARF as contractor). We are hoping for a first mailing this calendar year.
 - AW** reported the launch of PKC sports and active recreation strategy with various partners, some voluntary. **AW** will send a link to the strategy.
- Area reports:
 - Meikleour – no progress on footpath clearance. Road markings at the crossroads need redoing: **AE** will write Douglas Kent at PKC.
 - Clunie – Clunie Loch: **AE** will write to landowner Colin Cornes; arranging a meeting of interested parties was deferred; **AE** will contact David Merrie to stimulate complaints. Intention to install a meteorological mast at Dullatur has been received, pointing to future wind farm development. Forneth speed limit is under consultation.
 - Murthly - Hedge at Kinclaven Road X roads has been cut to some extent, freeing the footpath.
 - Caputh - Dogs have been reported in the playpark and the “no dogs” sign needs replaced (**BV** will pursue this within PKC).
- Review of Community Councils & Elections 2011: **AE** will put nomination forms in Murthly PO and Mobile Library; **HR** will put forms in Spittalfield.
- Correspondence was summarized
- Any Other Business:
 - Speed limits: it seems desirable to have 30 mph at Caputh on A984 east to Blinkbonnie. **AE** has written already and will write again to Roads Department saying so.
 - Thanks were expressed to **AE** for distributing speed limit consultation papers to residents.
