


Spittalfield & District Community Council



Minutes of meeting: 12th November 2014 Clunie Village Hall

- Apologies Sheena McPherson, Margaret Edwards
- Minutes of meeting of 17th September 2014 were adopted (JR, RMcl) and there were no matters arising.
- The recent election of JR and SMcP as our Murthly councillors was noted. The vacancy at Meikleour remains to be filled and an election will be held for Spittalfield on the 11th of December.
- The police report was received and **AE** will report to police that there are no local concerns.
- The A984 west of Caputh had almost been repaired and would soon be re-opened.
- Area reports: Murthly – complaints were noted of horse riding on pavement and consequent mess (later note: horse-riding on the pavement appears to be specifically illegal according to the Highways Act 1935). **AE** will write to Network Rail about the crossing. **GL** will approach the owner about an overhanging hedge. A matter of road safety near Caputh hostel is being considered by officers of Perth and Kinross Council. At Clunie, the Dulatur hill wind farm application is still in consultation – probably to be determined in January.
- Councillors' reports: PKC encourages everyone to be aware of the possibility of child abuse; if in doubt about the welfare of any child, consult council officers.

- The Community Payback team is now looking for winter work and the relevant officer is Roddy Ross in PKC.
