Minutes of Meeting Wednesday 18th February 2015 Spittalfield

- Minutes of meeting of 14th November 2014 were adopted (JMcl, AE)
- Sam Mercer Nairne was eligible for co-option and was approved unanimously as the member for Meikleour (JMcl, VM)
- Matters arising: The hedge at Murthly has been cut back.
- The police report was received and noted.
- There were no public matters of concern.
- Area reports: At Cluny the Dulater wind farm application consideration has now been extended to May 2015. It was agreed that the community council will pay for repair of the noticeboard damage. Murthly: We have been advised by the police that it is illegal to ride horses on the public footpath; AE will liaise with JR and SMcP and if more complaints are received the community police officer will be asked to intervene.
- Councillors' reports: in Perth, the Bertha park road improvements and any objections are in hand with PKC. It was agreed not to support an objection.
- Correspondence was summarised. The Community Economic Development Advisor will be invited to attend our meeting in June for a 15 minute presentation.
- Any Other Business: **GL** will liaise with roads department over the state of a layby at Lethendy.
- A local community litter pick is being organised.
