

SDCC 18th July 2018 Minutes of Meeting in Murthly Village Hall 7 pm

Present: Roddy McInnes, Jean Rae, Margaret Wilson, Dorothy Amos, Cllr Ian James, Sgt Nichola Forrester, 5 members of the public.

- **Adoption of minutes of 16th May 2018** - were taken as read and adopted (JR, MW).
- **Matters arising:** Dog litter, Pittensorn Rd, Murthly (AJ to speak with PKC, awaiting response).
- **Police report** – Sgt Nichola Forrester gave update on local policing matters (previously covered in Commanders bulletin). Sgt Forrester to progress the following issues:

Vehicles speeding through local villages and at Glendelvine School;

Anti-social behaviour around Clunie Loch, including litter pick by unpaid work team, additional bins and patrols by Police Officers/Community Wardens.

- **Public matters of concern** – Concern from Clunie Church representative and newly formed Friends of Clunie Loch regarding anti-social behaviour around the Church and Loch.

Letter received from Glendelvine School Parent regarding:

Speed of vehicles passing school (Sgt Forrester to progress);

Flashing speed limit signs not operating correctly (Cllr James to progress);

Flashing speed limit sign invisible to traffic emerging from Clunie junction (Cllr James to progress);

Speed limit/speeding traffic on roads from Caputh and Spittalfield to Glendelvine School (Cllr Laing/Sgt Forrester to progress).

- **Area Reports:**

Meikleour: none.

Caputh: Vehicles speeding through village (Sgt Forrester to progress); request for 30mph speed limit to be extended from village to bridge (Cllr Laing to progress).

Murthly: Overhanging hedge in Station Rd, Murthly (Cllr James to progress); road signs for Station/Kinclaven Roads (Cllr James to progress).

Clunie: still awaiting decision on proposed Dulater Hill Wind Farm; extension to Clunie Graveyard – RMcl has spoken with Snaigow Estate Factor and awaits revised proposals.

Spittalfield: none.

- **Councillors' Reports:**

Cllr Laing – submitted report on following: wall at Skiag, Murthly has been checked by Roads Dept, no imminent danger; road sign for HGVs on Over Forneth Road, awaiting timescale; dropped kerbs Broompark Crescent, Murthly now in programme for being done; traffic vehicle activated signs to be situated in Spittalfield, Caputh end of village this year; pavement from Caputh Bridge to Village has now been scored and came out as a priority – expected to be done this year to coincide with resurfacing work; horses sign in Pittensorn Road, Murthly not seen as priority but will pursue; road between Clunie crossroads and Snaigow House to have further repairs, to be resurfaced next year at a cost of £104,000; capital budget – main effect for Strathtay is removal of money to improve Stewart Tower Road, Murthly and Five Mile Wood Road, Stanley.

Cllr James – Similar points to Cllr Laing. Reported money remains in budget for Stewart Tower and Five Mile Roads.

Cllr Jarvis – submitted report on agreement for flashing speed limit signs at Spittalfield.
